Needs Analysis (NA) or Initial Assessment and Guidance (IAG) is a procedure to assess English language skills of new arrivals in order to place them on an appropriate ESOL course which helps them progress to the next level.

The purpose of this toolkit is to offer principles, guidance and a set of curated resources to support effective and holistic initial assessment, and to encourage a consistent approach among ESOL providers.
